

- your bull = Stock & Trade Management Plan


What is the Business Of Share Trading?



- Fri Night: Heavy lifting – Watchlist & Universe Review, Market Review, Portfolio Review
- Sat Morning: Scans, Filters & shortlist
- Sun Morning: Trade Selection and Admin

Streamline and systematise trade management processes

- Trade Log: Captures Trade Entry Details
- Trade Charts Log: Screen shot of charts @ Entry
- Trade Diary: Written Diary of my trades
- Playbook: Screen shot of example setups



Position Size

Position Size:

- Risk a fixed percentage % of your capital for every trade
 - Nominal amount i.e. 1%-5%
 - Calculated amount 2ATR (or ??)
 - Support or resistance level

Van Tharp:

$$\text{No. of Shares} = \frac{\% \text{ Risk Per Trade} \times \text{Capital}}{\text{ccRisk Per Share}}$$

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$$\text{No. of Shares} = \frac{3\% \times \$10,000}{\$0.47} = \frac{\$300}{\$0.47} = \$638$$

$$- \frac{\$638}{\$0.47} = \$0.47$$

$$\text{No. of Shares} = \frac{\$638}{\$0.47} = 40 \text{ Shares}$$
