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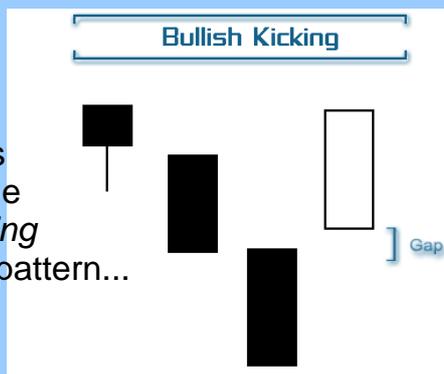

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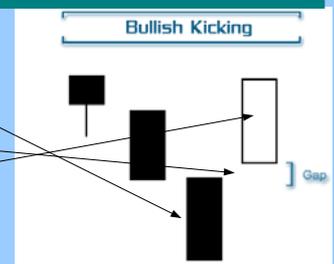
Recap — Candle patterns

Last month, Iliia Bermous described the *Bullish Kicking* candlestick pattern...



Bullish Kicking pattern

- After down trend or consolidation
- A tall black candle
- Price gaps up
- Marabozu
- Both candles have no shadows or only very small shadows
- Confirmation of the reversal on the third day should be sought.



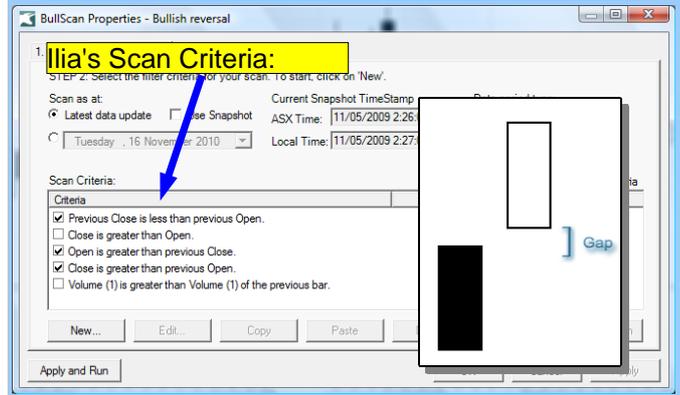
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Time periods?

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BullCharts Scan Criteria



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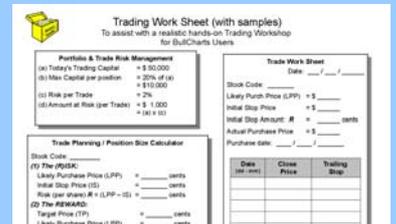

Portfolio & Trade Risk Management

- (a) Today's Trading Capital = \$ 50,000
 (b) Max Capital per position = 20% of (a)
 = \$10,000
 (c) Risk per Trade = 2%
 (d) Amount at Risk (per Trade) = \$ 1,000
 = (a) x (c)

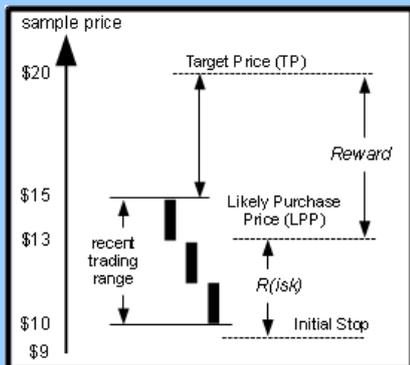

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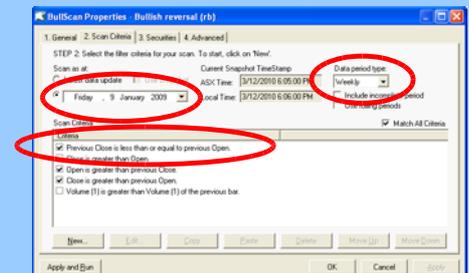
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Case Study Exercise #1

Determine your RISK:

- Likely Purchase Price (LPP)
- Initial Stop (IS)
- RISK per share

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More paper work

Determine your REWARD:

- Target Price (TP)
- Likely Purchase Price (LPP)
- REWARD per share

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Reward to Risk Ratio

$$\frac{\text{Reward}}{(\text{R})isk}$$

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Position Size

Position size (the number of shares to buy):

$$\frac{\text{Amount at risk (d)}}{(\text{R})isk}$$

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Value of this parcel

$$\text{The Parcel Size} \times \text{LPP} = \$ \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$
